Jean Suzanne Foster Bolton passed away peacefully at home on December 6, 2017. Jean was born in Mobile, Alabama, on November 6, 1946, to Dr. and Mrs. John Foster. She graduated from Foley High School in 1965, Duke University with a BA in 1969, and the University of Alabama with an MA in 1971. She graduated from the University of Alabama School of Medicine in 1979.

Jean married local attorney W. Donald Bolton, Jr., on June 4, 1971. They were blessed with 46 wonderful years of marriage, three children (Kate, Will, and Jeb) and four grandchildren (Charlotte, Annie, Addie, and Charlie).
