



Dorothy "Dot" Dorgan

October 11, 1931 - April 4, 2018

Dorothy "Dot" Dorgan, a resident of Point Clear, passed away at home on April 4, 2018. She was a 1949 graduate of Murphy High School and a retiree of Regions Bank (formerly Merchants National Bank) after a 36 - year banking career. Dot has the distinction of being the first woman officer in the history of Merchants National Bank. She was active in professional organizations, particularly the Banking Administration Institute, National Association of Bank Women and the Alabama Bankers Association. Dot was a faithful contributor and member of St. Francis at the Point for many years. Dot loved her family and friends unconditionally. She was known and loved for her quick wit and generous nature.
