



Doyle Ben Griffiths

September 29, 1926 - November 28, 2015

Doyle Benjamin Griffiths, 89, lifelong resident of Foley, passed away Saturday November 28, 2015. He is preceded in death by his parents Earl Benjamin and Mabel Roberts Griffiths, and his brother Earl William Griffiths. He is succeeded by his wife Elizabeth Dial Griffiths, 2 nephews, a great-niece, and 7 great-nephews. Visitation will be at Foley United Methodist Church Wednesday 10:00 am with memorial service at 11 am. Internment will be at 12 pm, Wynn Cemetery, Summerdale.

Doyle was born September 20, 1926 and grew up farming with his father and older brother. While attending Birmingham Southern College, he was drafted into the Army, and served in the Philippines. Upon returning from WWII, he finished his degree and returned to the farm. A few years later he was hired as a shift foreman at Monsanto in Pensacola. He became Manager of Monsanto Employees Credit Union, where he retired. Doyle also served on the board of Central Credit Union of Florida. After 42 years in the Army Reserves, he retired as Colonel.
