On March 2, 2021, Glenn Alan Page, Jr. departed his life on earth to spend eternity with his Heavenly Father.

Raised in Bay Minette, AL and a long-time resident of Magnolia Springs, AL, Glenn was a devoted husband and father. He never met a stranger and was always able to make everyone around him laugh. He was a master of hilariously accurate impressions when it came to people he knew.

In his earlier years, Glenn attended Marion Military Institute and became a scratch golfer-turned-pro golfer shortly after graduation. Glenn went on to proudly serve in the United States Army in Vietnam and in Germany. He fought alongside many soldiers in the Vietnam War with Advisory Team 73 and was awarded several medals. Later in Germany, he worked as professional golfer and trained fellow soldiers as well as highly decorated generals in the sport.

Back in the United States, Glenn married and became a father to two children, Caroline and Glenn A. Page III (Bucky). In 1993 he married the love of his life, Mary (Rutherford) Page and became a stepfather to her daughter, Elizabeth Ann. He spent time working in the FBI and the car industry before retiring.
