



## Mr. Harold Lars Larsen

Harold Lars Larsen was born on May 7, 1938, in Elmwood Park, Illinois to Harold and Lucille (Lou) Larsen. He was nicknamed "Skip"; by his older brother Dane and had two younger siblings, Mary and Don. At a young age, Skip developed a love for the Chicago Cubs and worked as a patrol boy outside Wrigley Field. He attended high school and college in El Paso, Texas.

Skip had a 34-year career at the Chevron Refinery in El Paso, Texas working in various positions, lastly as a contract administrator. He was very proud of the work he did at Chevron and of the dear friends he made during that time. In "retirement" Skip became a Walmart greeter and a marshal at Soldier's Creek Golf Course.

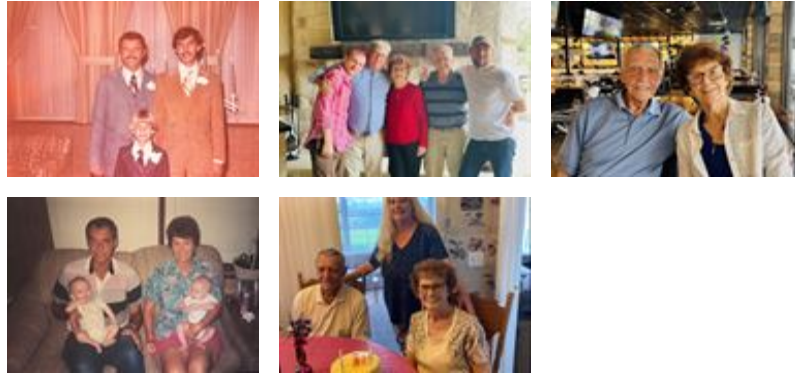
