Howell Scott Stinson (1955-2022)

Scott Stinson of West Palm Beach, Florida passed away peacefully on May 25, 2022, at the Veterans Administration West Palm Beach Healthcare Hospice Center. Scott was born in 1955. in Anniston, Alabama the son of the late Thomas Edwin and Julia Brown Stinson. During the last three years Scott lived a peaceful life under the medical care of the West Palm Beach Veterans Medical Center.
