November 25, 1928 - February 23, 2021

Jacqueline (Jackie) Lois Seavall was born to Jack L. Warden and Violet Sampson Warden on November 25, 1928 in Ft. Dodge, Iowa. In 1936 Jackie's parents moved with her to South Beloit, Illinois where she grew up attending school and worked until 1947 when she entered Augustana Hospital Nurses training program in Chicago, Illinois. On May of 1950 she met Gustav Seavall at Waverly Ballroom Dance Hall in Beloit, Wisconsin. They fell in love and were married on September 30, 1950. Over the years they lived in Alden; Illinois, Walworth; Wisconsin, Crystal Lake; Illinois. Then in the summer of 1988 she moved with her husband to Foley, Alabama. She was a faithful member of First Presbyterian Church of Foley until she suffered a stroke in 2017 and was home bound.

Jackie had three children Nancy, Janet, and Brian. Proceeding Jackie into heaven were her daughter Janet Butcher in 1979 and husband, Gustav Seavall, in 2012. She was blessed with 9 grandchildren (Charity, Cindy, Brent, Steve, Summer, Savannah, Kaylee, Daniel, and Serenity), and 5 Great grandchildren (Zach, Catherine, Reese, Lucy and Brielle). She is survived by her children Nancy Adrian (married to Greg Adrian) of Wichita, Kansas, and Brian Seavall of Foley and also her brother Bruce Warden of Rockford, Ill.

Jackie passed away at home with her family on the morning of February 23, 2021 during her sleep. She will be buried next to her husband Gustav Seavall, at Pine Rest Cemetery in Foley, AL on Friday, February 26, 2021 at 2:00pm.

Jackie had a huge heart and was always willing to start-up a conversation. She lived her life fully devoted to Christ and showed love to everyone. She will be greatly missed, but never forgotten, as the love she showed all lives on by her family.

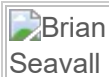
