John was born October 26, 1946 in Danville, Pennsylvania the son of the late John and Dorothy McCormick. After graduating from Danville High School, he attended the University of Maryland where he earned a degree in Fire Protection engineering. His career started with Consolidated Nuclear Security in Oak Ridge, Tennessee. From there he joined Rolf Jensen and Associates as a Fire Protection Consultant Manager and in 1996 became a partner with Code Consultants, Inc. in St. Louis, Missouri. In 1999, John opened the New York City office for Code Consultants and managed that office until his retirement in 2008.

John and Anne loved their retirement in Gulf Shores. John was an active golfer, served on the Boards and was president of the Gulf Shores Athletic Club (GCAC) and Cotton Creek Men's Golf Association (CCMGA). He was a staff volunteer for the Annual Gulf Shores Shrimp Festival in charge of the "Best of Fest" and Sand Sculpture events. Most recently, he served as the Vice-Chairman of the Board of Directors of Gulf Shores Utility.
