Joy Imogene Thompson, 94 was called home to be with the Lord on Friday November 22, 2019. Born April 1, 1925 to Cecil Agnew Thompson, Sr and Jessie Rawls Lowery Thompson, in Stapleton AL. Joy lived up to her name and was a joyful daughter, wife, mother and friend. She will be remembered as a strong support for her family. She was ever present with her steady helping hand and servant heart.

Joy Imogene was raised in Bay Minette AL and attended Huntington College and graduated from Auburn University with a degree in Early Childhood Education. She had plans to be the director of an Early Childhood Program in Miami FL, but was persuaded instead to marry. In April 1948, she married her late husband, Joseph Earl Cook of Foley AL and became his strong helper. She supported her husband in his career and after moving throughout Alabama they were transferred to Nashville TN. There, she raised her three children, Glenn, Gale, and James T. Joy was a devoted Kindergarten Teacher, Sunday School teacher, and tireless worker in her church for many years.
