Larry Berman, 74, of Foley, Alabama, passed away on January 3, 2024. Larry was born in Washington, D.C., and raised in Silver Spring, Maryland. He was active in many extracurricular activities throughout his youth and attained the rank of Eagle Scout with the Boy Scouts of America. An ardent believer in service, he volunteered for the U.S. Army and eventually deployed to Vietnam. Following Larry's decorated combat service in Vietnam, he and his wife, Debbie, by whom he was predeceased, eventually made Virginia their home, where they worked and raised a family for over 40 years.
