Foley, Ala.-Nancy Elaine Pea, 68, died July 26, 2023, in her home following a lengthy illness. She was a former resident of Fishers and Terre Haute, Ind., and Ballwin MO., before moving to Foley after retirement.

She served in the nursing profession for 40 years as a staff nurse, specializing in pediatrics nursery and neonatal intensive care, and as an instructor at St. Mary's School of Nursing, Barnes Hospital School of Nursing, St. Charles Community College of Nursing, Jefferson College School of Nursing, and St. Louis Community College School of Nursing. She served as a faculty sponsor for the National Students Nurses Association and was a member of NLN, NOADN, and NICSCS. She was a member of Alpha Chi Omega sorority. She earned her bachelor's degree at Indiana State University and her master's degree from University of Phoenix.

She loved to travel and cruises, needlepoint, and was a loyal fan of the St. Louis Cardinals and the St. Louis Blues. She was born October 13, 1954, at Beech Grove, Indiana to Lloyd C. and Mary Bolander, both preceding her in death. Survivors include her husband of 43 years, Richard J. Pea; two sons and daughters-in-law: Matthew and Krystal Nicole Pea of Ackerman, MS, and Andrew Pea and Meredith Ulmer of Worthington, OH.; four grandchildren: Brandt Pea, Anderson Pea, Canton Pea, and Elli Elaine Pea; a sister, Sandra Feazel of Newburgh, IN; and three brothers: Terry Jones of Lapel, IN., Garry Jones of Indianapolis, IN., and Scott Jones of Noblesville, IN.
