Palmore "Duke" Reed DuPuy was born on May 4, 1936, and went to be with the Lord on November 10, 2023, leaving behind a legacy of service, leadership, and unwavering love. He was a man whose impact reached far and wide, touching the lives of many with his warmth, dedication, and genuine kindness.

Duke dedicated 33 years of his life to the United States Post Office, culminating in a distinguished career as the Postmaster in Saint Petersburg, FL. His commitment and leadership were further exemplified when he was selected as one of only 800 employees nationwide for the prestigious Executive Leadership Program, a testament to his exceptional abilities and dedication to his profession.

Beyond his career, Duke selflessly volunteered for several years with the United States Coast Guard Auxiliary at the Aviation Training Center (ATC), Sector Mobile, AL. His service to the nation extended far beyond his professional responsibilities, reflecting a deep sense of duty and patriotism. He was also the recipient of the prestigious Arkansas Traveler Award, which is an honorary title bestowed on notable individuals, who through their actions, serve as goodwill ambassadors of the state of Arkansas.

Palmore "Duke" Reed DuPuy was born to Hugh P. DuPuy and Juanita (Urrey) DuPuy in Hope, AR. He was preceded in death by his parents and his daughter, Kim (DuPuy) Toner of Las Vegas, NV. Duke is survived by his loving

wife, Ouida (Blount) DuPuy of Lillian, AL, and his sister Patricia Jones of Tyler, TX. Additionally, he leaves behind a blended family, stepchildren: Jaye Hamblet and spouse, John, of Gainesville, FL; Jamie Doty and spouse Steve, of Wichita, KS; Laura Hadley and spouse, Scott, of Gulf Shores, AL; Todd Joyner and spouse Carla, of West Palm Beach, FL. Duke is also survived by six grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

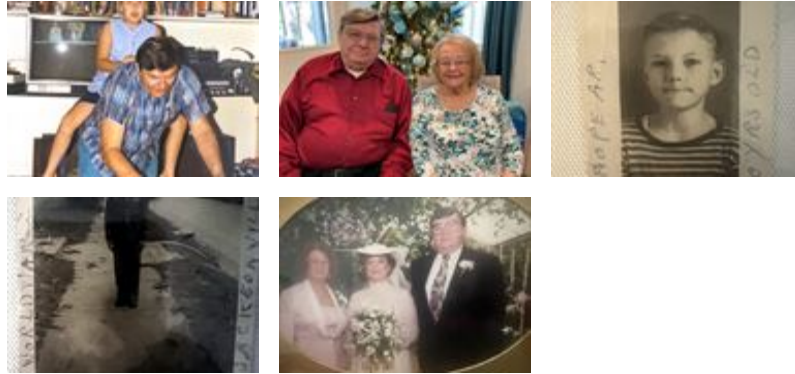
