Born on July 28, 1949 in Denver, CO, he was raised by loving parents Glenn and Laverne Yeazel. He graduated in 1967 from Ranum High School in Westminster, CO and served in the Navy for six years. Bill and Linda married December 2, 1971, at Life Temple and soon left for International Bible College in San Antonio, TX. Bill graduated from IBC in 1975 after the birth of Kelly Ann. A year later, Erin was born. Her first birthday was in Bogota, Columbia, where the family served as missionaries with Ivan and Ruthie Potter, also graduates of IBC. After returning to Colorado, Bill became Associate Pastor alongside his father at Life Temple, in Arvada, CO for the next ten years. They were blessed early during this time with their youngest daughter Sara. In 1989 the family moved to the Western Slope of CO. In 2009 Bill worked for the National Park System on Cape Cod, MA (Where work was literally a walk on the beach). Next, he worked on the FDR Mansion in Hyde Park, NY as well as other sites near there. His final job was at the National Ammunitions Plant in McAlester, OK. Bill served as minister of and on throughout his life while working as a finish carpenter to pay the bills. Retiring in 2018, Bill and Linda settled in Foley, AL. They became members of Anchor Point Church serving on the Missionary Team for Feed Foley in the summer and as Small Group Leaders to Seniors. They were surrounded by many kind and loving friends led by Pastors Todd and Avery Forrest. Bill was preceded in
