Robert Thomas Britt, age 80 passed away peacefully in his sleep at his home in Foley Alabama on the afternoon of May 5, 2018.

Born and raised in Elizabethton, Tennessee

Served in the Navy for 10 years working as welder on an aircraft carrier. After he retired from the Navy he moved his young family to Alexandria VA. And worked as a welder/ pipe fitter with Steamfitter Local Union 602 in Alexandria Virginia.
