Robert Edward Morrow, 81, of Foley passed away Thursday March 7, 2024, at his residence.

He was born May 26, 1942, to Bob Ed and Clevie Walker Morrow. Bob graduated from Albert G Parrish High School in Selma, AL and obtained his law degree from the University of Alabama. Bob went on to become a Deputy Attorney General for the State of Alabama, District Attorney for the 4TH Judicial Circuit of Alabama, General Counsel for the Department of Public Safety and attorney for the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners. He was a member of the Alabama Trial Lawyers Association and a past President of the District Attorneys' Association of Alabama. LTC Morrow served in the Alabama Army National Guard for 26 years. He was also in private practice in Selma, Alabama where he was a member of the Houston Park Church of Christ and a lifetime member of the F.O.P. He proudly led the Attorney General's team of prosecutors who received a death penalty conviction against the mail bomber of Federal Judge Robert Vance in Birmingham. Bob enjoyed boating and the outdoors with his family and friends. He always enjoyed telling humorous true stories about his many years in law enforcement.

He is survived by his wife of 51 years Marolyn Hargrove Morrow, son William Robert "Robbie" Morrow, granddaughter Kenadi McGhee, sister Nancy Harris,

brother John Morrow, stepmother Patricia Morrow and brother-in-law Fort Hargrove.

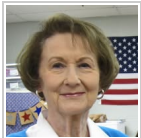
